Dear Parents, Carers and Class members of 4W,

It has been great to welcome all the children back to school this week. I am very excited to share our learning for this term and look forward to a great year ahead!

English and Maths

In **English** topics will be Myths and Legends, Recounts, Traditional Tales and Fables, Reports and Narrative Poetry

In **Maths** will be focusing on decimals, fractions, multiplication, division, addition, subtraction and shape

Our other topics this term:

- **Our IPC topic is Temples, Tombs and Treasures (Ancient Egypt)**
- **Science: Sound and Electricity**
- **RE: Will be continue to be taught through whole days including Hinduism and Sikhism**
- **PE: Gymnastics, Dance, Striking and fielding games**
- **Art and DT: We will have Art and DT weeks**

PE kit: Our days for PE are Monday's and Thursday's. Children must have their PE kit in school on these days. There may be other days when we choose to do PE, so it is important that PE kits stay in school every day. For outdoor PE the children will need dark coloured tracksuit trousers and a jumper for when the weather is colder. In year 4 **trainers** are preferred choice of footwear as they are suitable for all weathers rather than plimsolls.

Homework:

Spellings: They will have spellings given to them on **Tuesdays** and then tested on **Monday**

Learning Logs: They will be sent home on **Friday** and returned by the following **Thursday**

Times Table Rock Stars and Athletics: Online times table programme accessed through <https://trockstars.com/login> and <https://login.mathletics.com/>. Your child will have their log in details inside their reading record.

How to support your child?

- Ensure your child is reading their reading books at home and discuss these with them.
Please ensure you sign your child's record book when you read with them at home each night
- Discuss learning logs tasks
- Ensure your child knows their times tables. Children need to know all times tables in year 4. We will be busy preparing for the year 4 multiplication check this term.
- Help your child to learn their spellings

Trips: We hope to arrange some exciting trips for this term and will be in touch with details shortly.

School Uniform: We take pride in our appearance! Please remember to ensure that your child comes to school every day wearing correct uniform. This includes black trousers or skirts. Leggings must not be worn and suitable black schools, not trainers.

All children need school book bags and small PE bags, no rucksacks as we do not have space for these.

All children must bring a named water bottle to school every day. If you or your child has any questions throughout the term, please speak to myself on the playground at the end of the school day.
