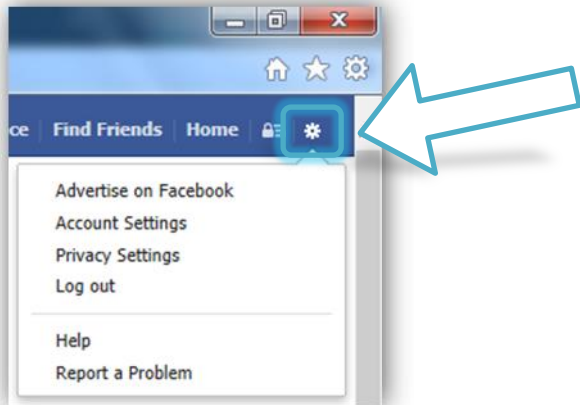


# PAFG - How to secure your social networks (Facebook October 2013)

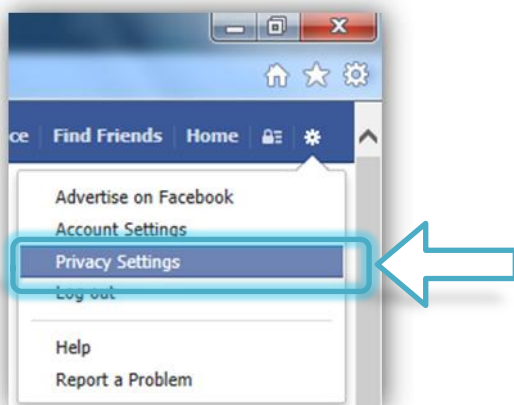
## Step 1

On Facebook, once you have logged in. Click on settings.



## Step 2

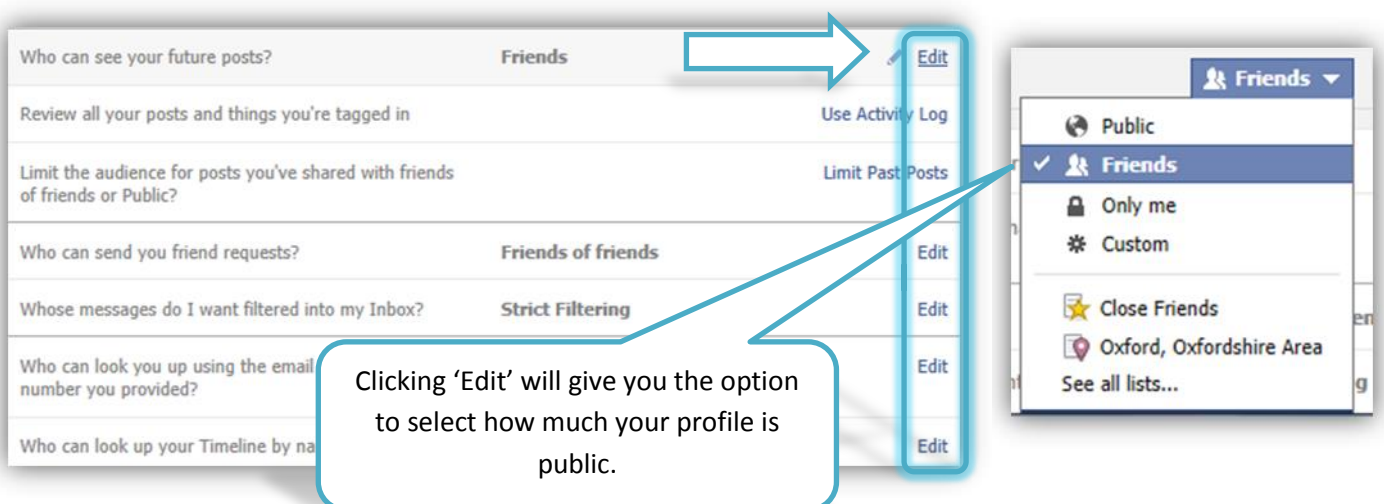
Once settings has been clicked, a drop down menu of available settings will appear in which you can change. Click on 'Privacy Settings'.

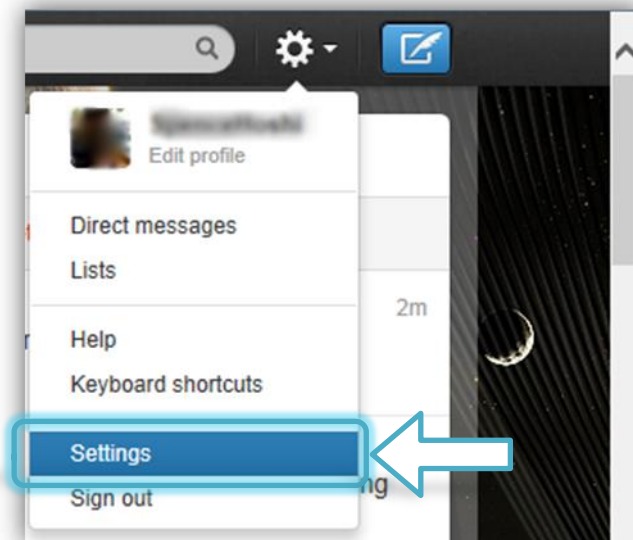
### Step 1

Once you have logged into Twitter, at the top right corner of the website. Click on the settings icon.



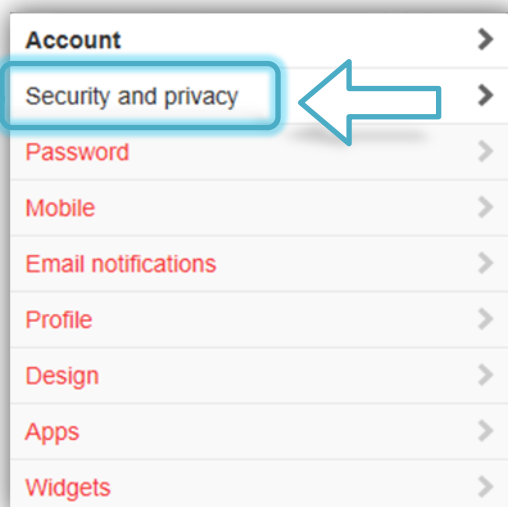
### Step 2
