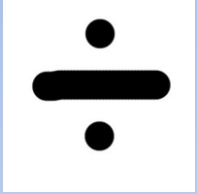

If a child has a reminder in the first lesson, they will miss playtime.

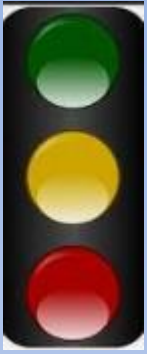
NOT HAVING PE KIT = 2 reminders. Swearing = 4 Reminders

Children will also bring home a book of their choice from our class library to share and read with you.

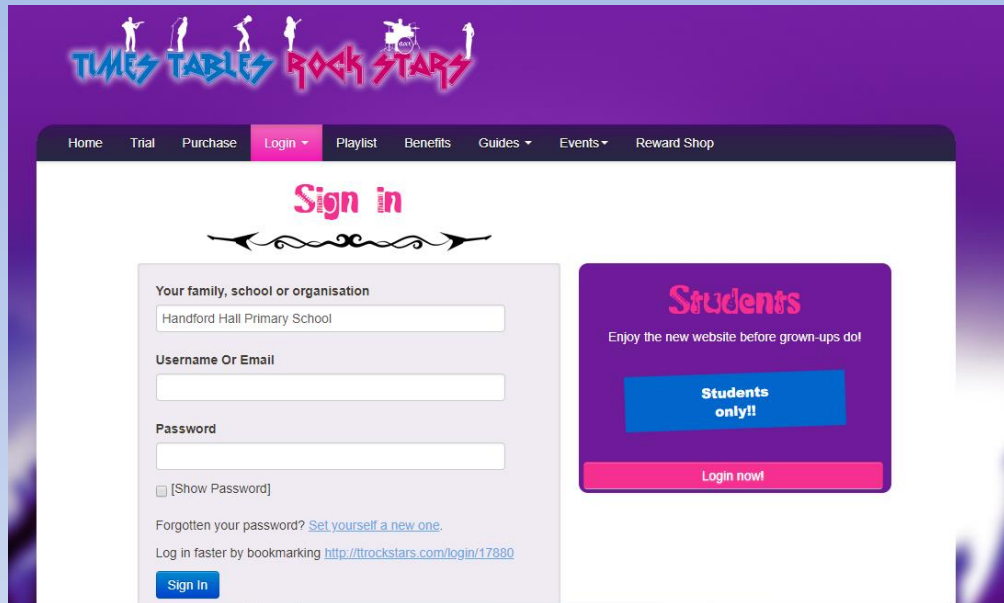
Year 2 children move on to Accelerated Read. This book is at their reading level and they are very proud to read these books.
