Safer Internet Day at HH - whole school assembly led by Mr Harraway. So many questions regarding AI and its responsible use.

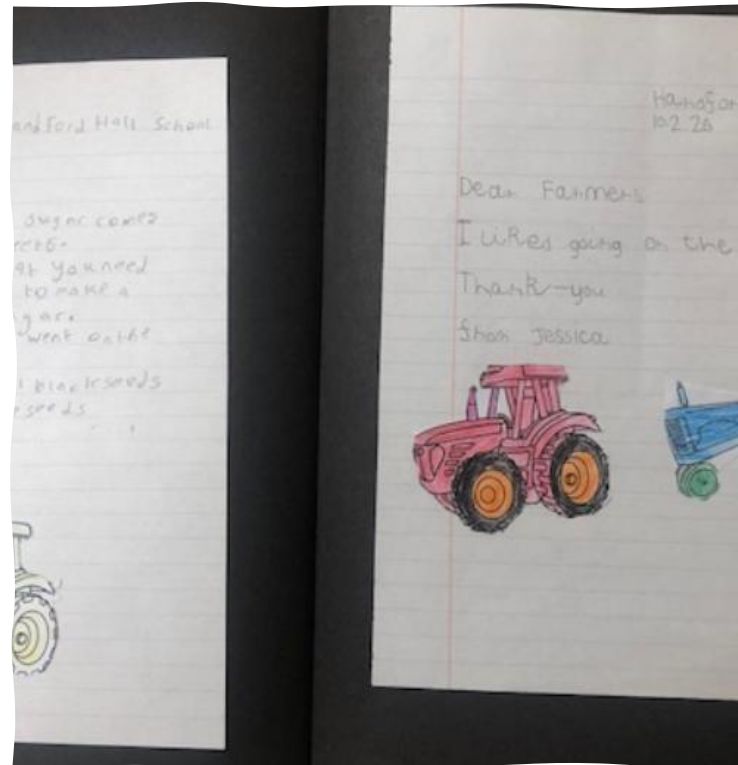

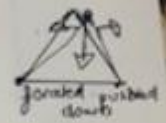

Using gyoones to support vertical structures.

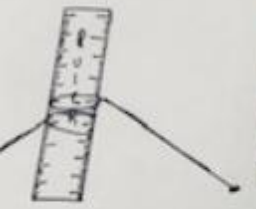


The method that we used is doing triangular-based points and square-based points.

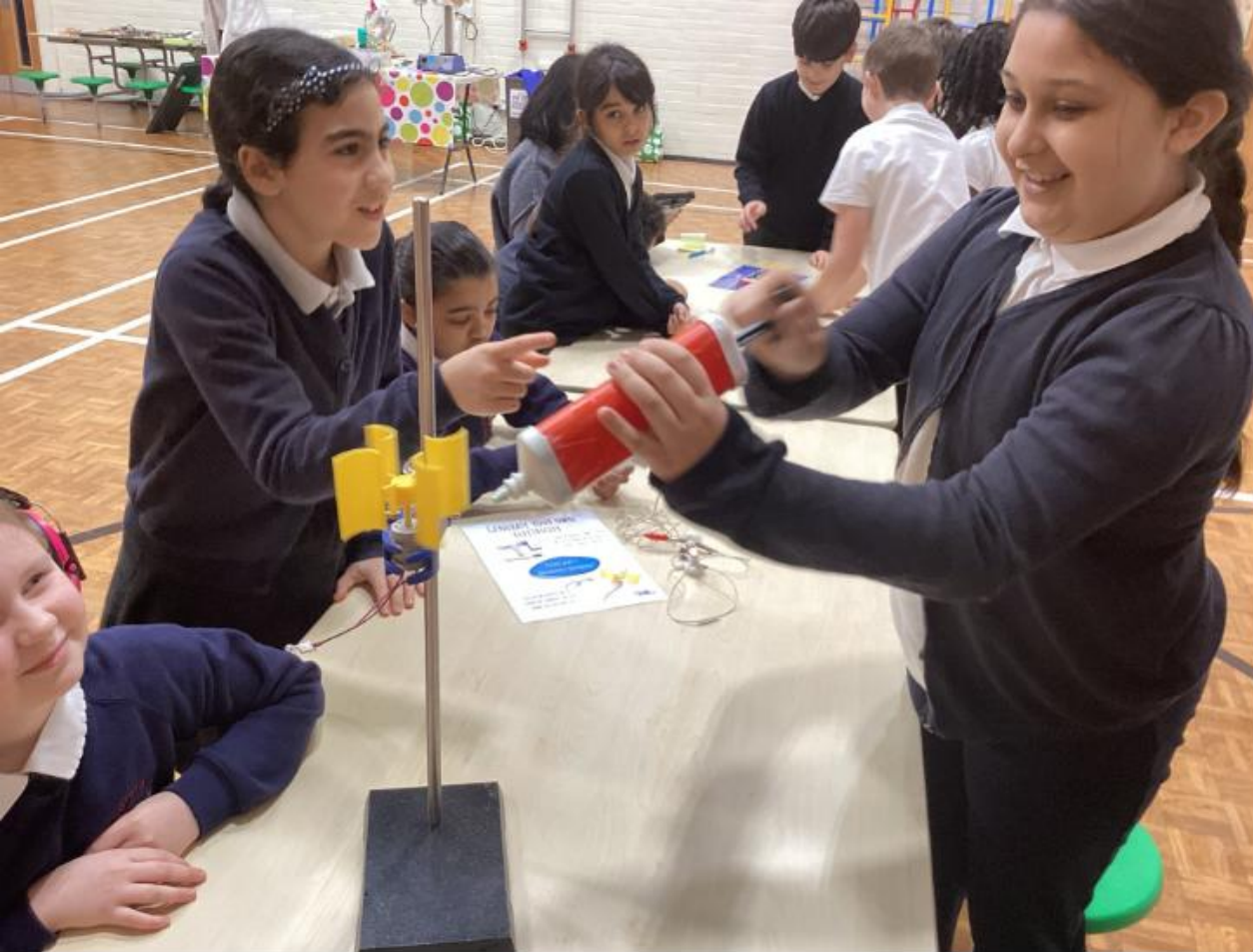


Growing future scientists

Year 4 have explored the fascinating culture of the Ancient Egyptians in Virtual Reality



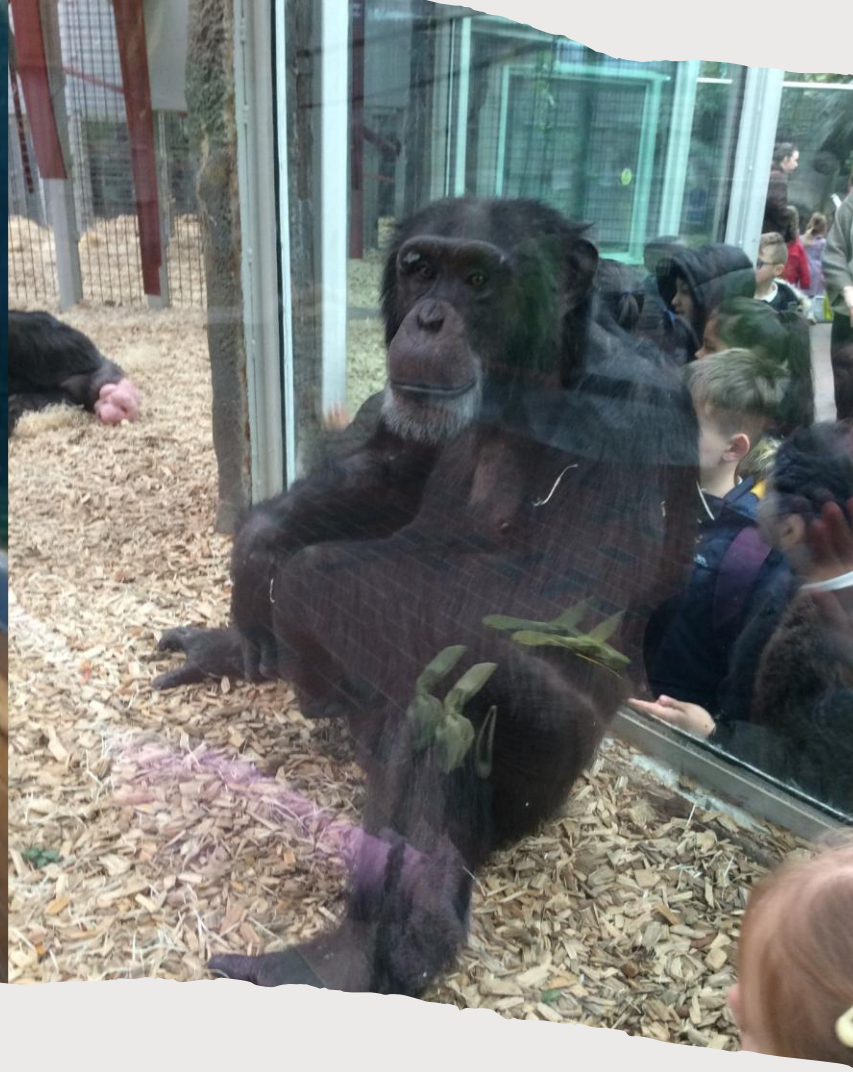


Dance East Year 6 dance workshop
